Seahawks BIG Man Anthony Allen is BIG News Nationally



PORT ARTHUR, TX – Port Arthur Freshmen Center Anthony Allen led the Nation in Blocked Shots during the 2012-13 season. He is the first Seahawk to lead the Nation in any statistical category, and led all divisions in both total blocks and blocks per game. The Lamar State program has been a NJCAA affiliate for only 5 years and Allen will be remembered in the history books of the college forever.

"He is our most improved player this year. Anthony has worked really hard to get in great physical condition, he takes pride in his defense, and has become a defensive force for us as the tear has progressed," commented Seahawks Head Coach Lance Madison. Allen has only been playing organized basketball for five years since moving to the United States from Jamaica. The Seahawks will enjoy another season with the "Human Block Party," as Allen will return for his sophomore season.
